Failure to supply the requested information, or to sign the disclaimer, will delay the processing of your application.

Accreditation provides access to the media facilities in the Rally HQ and in the Service Park(s), also designated areas in Special Stages.

ACCREDITATION GUIDELINES

1. INTERNATIONAL and NATIONAL PRINT MEDIA & PHOTOGRAPHERS

Requests from the above must be sent by **Friday 1st October 2010** to:

- a) Up to a maximum of **three (3)** representatives per organisation will be considered for accreditation. A separate application form should be submitted for each person to be accredited.
- b) To be accredited, a publication must:
 - i) have a circulation size and quality that satisfies the criteria of the IRC.
 - ii) be on sale to the public.

3. INFORMATION TO BE SUPPLIED WITH EACH APPLICATION

- a) A formal request for accreditation, written on the publication's official letterhead, signed by a Director of the publication or the Editor. Requests signed by clerical staff will not be accepted.
- b) A completed Accreditation Form (See Page 2).
- c) Written confirmation of the publication's frequency and circulation or readership figures.
- d) A current and original copy of the publication.
